

HOW TO DONATE YOUR DEER

Donating a deer through Hunters Sharing the Harvest is a very simple process. Drop off a whole deer at one of our participating processors found closest to where you live or hunt.

Simply follow these steps to donate a deer:

1. ENJOY A SAFE AND SUCCESSFUL HUNT.
2. TAG, FIELD DRESS AND REPORT YOUR DEER HARVEST.
3. TAKE THE WHOLE DEER TO ANY HSH PROCESSOR NEAR WHERE YOU HUNT OR LIVE.
4. COMPLETE THE HSH DONOR RECEIPT FORM VERIFYING YOUR DONATION.
5. KNOW YOU JUST HELPED FEED THE HUNGRY IN PENNSYLVANIA.

HSH is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization and your contribution is tax deductible. Licensed hunters can donate whole deer through one of our many participating processors. Thanks to our sponsors and financial supporters, **there is no cost to the hunter when donating deer.** Just bring your field-dressed deer to a participating butcher shop and fill out a donor receipt used for tracking and reimbursement by the Hunters Sharing the Harvest (HSH) program. The processed, bagged and frozen meat is taken to the nearest food bank or assistance agency for distribution to the food insecure.

HUNTERS SHARING THE HARVEST HAS COORDINATED THE PROCESSING AND DISTRIBUTION OF DONATED VENISON FROM HUNTERS TO HUNGRY PEOPLE THROUGHOUT PENNSYLVANIA.

This sportsmen-inspired outreach program effectively channels wholesome venison via a network of registered and inspected deer processors and food banks to local charitable organizations in our urban and rural communities. HSH has evolved as a respected partner with deer management practices throughout the Commonwealth, and together with the state's charitable food network, we are able to help put food on the tables of hungry Pennsylvanians.

The HSH program is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit Pennsylvania charitable organization with funding and support derived from a mix of public and private sources. HSH has developed into a preferred, nationally recognized model many other states have utilized. HSH was founded as the signature mechanism for Pennsylvania hunters to demonstrate their personal and compassionate decision for helping low-income individuals and families with extra venison. Many wildlife management units in Pennsylvania offer multiple antlerless deer tags, longer seasons and special hunting opportunities that result in extra deer being donated to our program.

The HSH program's success is due to the cooperation of our processors, volunteer county coordinators, board of directors, state legislators, state and local agencies, many supporters and sponsors who help fund the program.

We are thankful to be supported in our messaging by our colleagues from a dedicated outdoor news media. All these components work together with a common mission to maximize the best-utilization of a valuable wildlife resource to help others needing food assistance.

HSH remains the most effective social service program for hunters and wildlife managers to directly make a difference for those in need. More than 1.5 million Pennsylvanians are classified as food insecure, and as recent economic reports indicate, the need and requests for food assistance continue to grow.

HSH seeks those individuals and organizations who can educate the public about our mission, donate to our cause, and participate in their own unique way for the benefit of this statewide program. Donations of deer, financial support, HSH sponsorships and grants, and volunteers donating their time are all greatly needed to fuel this program.
